FIRST CONTACT WITH YOUR STUDENT

Students will usually message you around one week before arrival.

Please reply as soon as possible. A warm response helps students feel welcomed and reassured, particularly as many may be travelling abroad or staying in a homestay for the first time.

Hosting starts from the moment they reach out to introduce themselves.

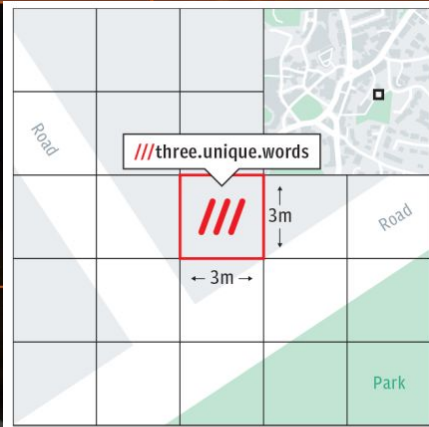

WHAT



The app divides the planet's surface into grids measuring 3x3m and uses an algorithm to assign a unique three-word marker to each of the 57 trillion squares, giving a much simpler, yet accurate, locator mark than a lengthy grid reference
